The members of the Board of Polish Society of Human Genetics (PTGC) would like to recommend Mrs. Ewelina Bukowska-Olech, MSc, for the ESHG 2020 National Fellowship.

Mrs. Bukowska-Olech works as molecular biologist at the Chair and Department of Medical Genetics, Poznan University of Medical Sciences in Poland. She is also a student of PhD studies at the same University. Mrs. Bukowska-Olech is 34 now, and she became a member of PTGC in 2014.

She has impressive research experience, including the participation in scientific projects held at the Chair and Department of Medical Genetics in Poznan and academic scholarship at the Institute of Human Genetics University Greifswald, Greifswald, Germany. Her scientific interests focus on congenital defects in humans as well as on cancer genetics.

She co-authored manuscripts published in recognized Polish and foreign journals, i.e. Journal of Human Genetics, Clinical Genetics; cumulative impact factor of these publications for the period 2015 - 2020 is 19.68.

Mrs. Bukowska-Olech very actively participates in genetic conferences and courses, including Congresses of Polish Society of Human Genetics, and ESHG Conferences. She was granted with Poster Prize in Molecular Genetics at the IX Congress of PTGC, which was held in Bydgoszcz in 2018.

At this year's ESHG conference she would like to present the results of two studies: 1. *Molecular screening of patients with tuberous sclerosis complex* and 2. *Heterozygous 7q32.3-q35 deletion causes syndromic craniosynostosis*.

The opportunity to participate in the ESHG conference in Berlin will be associated with the unique chance for Mrs. Bukowska-Olech to meet scientists who are authorities in the field of human genetics. She is strongly convinced that it would benefit her studies, help in establishment of new collaborations and allow her to better contribute to the area of human genetics.
